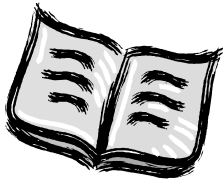

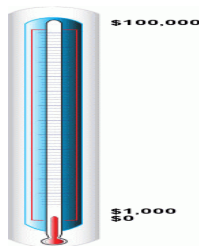

May 23 – Pentecost Sunday

“To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit.” 1Cor 12:3b-7, 12-13

It has been seven weeks and one day since Easter Sunday. It is Pentecost (from the Greek word for “fiftieth”), the day on which the Holy Spirit encouraged the Apostles to proclaim Jesus Christ to people from many nations, cultures, languages and religious beliefs. Each person heard the Apostles in his or her own tongue. Amazing! Even more amazing is that people with a variety of religious beliefs came to believe in Jesus. Later, Paul writes to Christians in Corinth, a very diverse seaport city, and he tells them something so obvious we often forget it: Each of us is a person with a unique array of talents, abilities and gifts that God has given to us to use for ourselves and for others – material wealth, intelligence, musical and artistic talent, athletic ability, and many others.

God intends for us to enjoy them ourselves and to share them with others. How are we doing with that? One day God will ask.
