To purchase a Luminary “In Honor” of someone or “In Memory” of someone, you simply fill out the Luminary Form and make a \$10 contribution.

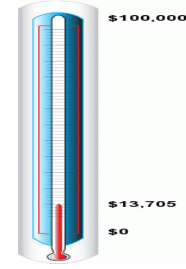
