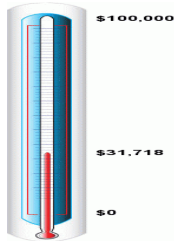
### June 26<sup>th</sup> -27<sup>th</sup>

--Luke 7:36-8:3

Kenny Rogers sings a Country Western Song, "Oh Lord it is hard to be humble when you are perfect in every way." Could it be our theme song? Is the fact that we might be mistaken or wrong pretty far down on our list of possibilities? And we are proud of that? The ability to admit that we are in error or done evil does not come easy. For many people, the three most difficult words are not "I love you", but "I am wrong" and "I am sorry". And there is the always difficult "I forgive you!"
